

Post-Visit Activity OR Fieldtrip Experience 6th – 8th grade Field Experience Speaking Volumes: Transforming Hate

Simple Accordion Book

In this activity students will be given the opportunity to respond to the exhibition Speaking Volumes: Transforming Hate by creating a handmade book using the collage process and torn pages from the white supremacist books that the exhibition artist used.



Materials Needed

Copy of "Simple Accordion Book" instructions
Glue Sticks
81/2 x 11 paper (one for each student) any color
Scissors
Waxed Linen thread
Darning Needles
Small Awls or other tool for poking holes
Several copies of Ben Klassen's books or pages torn from those books
Examples of symbols that could be used (peace sign, dove, etc.)
Pencils, markers, colored pencils
Example of finished books

Procedure

Instruct students on how to create the simple accordion book form using the attached instruction page. Once the basic book form is made students can collage torn or cut book pages, add original or found poetry, quotes, drawing, magazine letters, (the choices are endless) to cover design and create their message.
